Students in Media and Communications examine communication in all its richness and complexity while studying mass media and popular culture. They study digital and non-digital channels represented in social media, film, music, and literature. There are two degree programs within Media and Communications: Digital Media and Production, and Media and Culture. Those within the Digital Media and Production stream also develop talents in screenwriting, journalism, videography, video editing, audio production, and graphic and web design. They can produce short films and podcasts, author articles, and interpret media thoughtfully for others, themselves, and their world. For third and fourth year students, an internship gives them an opportunity to further their knowledge and skills in an applied setting, while earning academic credit. Digital Media and Production and Media and Culture are Bachelor of Arts degree programs within the Media and Communication Studies Department.

EXPECTATIONS

Employers commit to providing a learning experience relevant to the student's area of study and career development. Responsibilities of the employer supervisor include:

- Provide an *Internship Work Proposal*
- Sign the *Internship Agreement*
- Meet with the faculty supervisor
- Initiate the orientation process
- Prepare weekly learning activities
- Identify opportunities for the student to develop core competencies
- Offer guidance, mentoring, and feedback
- Schedule regular meetings with the student
- Review the student's progress
- Complete and submit the evaluation to the faculty supervisor
